

Other names for Planet X

Other names and history for this planet:

- Zacharia Sitchin called the **12th Planet**.
- NASA called **Planet X or 10th planet** when they discovered it inbound in 1983.
- The Bible calls this planet **Wormwood** and in book of Revelations 12-3 as **A great red dragon**.
- The ancient Summarians called **Nibiru**.
- The Incas call it **Hercolubus**.
- The Kolbrin calls it **the destroyer**.
- The Oahspe calls it the **Red Star**.
- The Babylonians called it **Marduk**.

ZetaTalk explains this as **Planet X or 12th planet**, located in 1983 by the JPL infrared team and denied every since to quell panic. Found in the direction of the constellation Orion ... so close in fact that it would be the nearest heavenly body to Earth beyond the outermost planet Pluto. (Washington Post, Dec 31, 1983)

Years ago, **Zecharia Sitchin** (linguistic scholar & historian of ancient Hebrew, Sumerian, Akkadian, and other early Mesopotamian civilizations) published his book "The 12Th Planet" (1976). This discusses the periodic return to our solar system of a large, red planet called **Nibiru** by ancient Sumerian historians. Nibiru was and still is the home to a race of war-prone service-to-shelf hominids referred to in ancient texts by either their earlier Sumerian name of **Anunnaki** or their later Hebrew name of **Nefilim**. Velikovsky wrote "Worlds in Collision".
